



Kenneth Moulton 2023 Student Scholarship Program

The Kenneth Moulton Scholarship Program, through the Windsor Rotary Community Foundation, offers a scholarship of \$2,000 to a graduating senior who attends the North Bay Met Academy, Windsor Oaks Academy, or other alternative education program in the Windsor Unified School District.

Qualifications

1. Enrollment in the North Bay Met Academy, Windsor Oaks Academy, or other alternative program offered by the Windsor Unified School District.
2. Eligibility for graduation.
3. Acceptance and enrollment in an accredited two-year junior college, four-year college, trade skill program, or career certificate program. The scholarship amount will be paid directly to the institution upon proof of enrollment.
4. Life experiences demonstrating the Rotary core values of empathy, resilience, leadership, perseverance, innovation, integrity, tolerance and service.
5. School and community service, citizenship, and leadership will be considered in awarding this Scholarship.
6. If awarded a scholarship, you have **ONE YEAR** from the award date to claim this scholarship.

Application Requirements

- ☐ Complete all requirements of the application.
- ☐ Attach a one-page (single spaced) typed essay sharing a challenge you've experienced and how two or more of the core values of Rotary assisted you in addressing this challenge (See qualification 4 above).
- ☐ Attach a copy of your High School transcript and proof of eligibility for graduation.
- ☐ Include **two** letters of recommendation. **One** from a school employee: teacher, counselor, or administrator, and **One** from a community member expressing their recognition of your demonstration of the core values of Rotary in your life.
