



2026 WRCF Student Scholarship Program

The Windsor Rotary Community Foundation is offering several one-time scholarships to graduating seniors who attend Windsor High School in Windsor, CA.

Qualifications

1. Enrollment in Windsor High School.
2. You must be eligible for graduation from school.
3. If awarded a scholarship, you must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited two-year junior college, four-year college, trade skill program, or career certificate program to receive it. The scholarship amount of \$2,000 will be paid directly to the institution upon proof of enrollment.
4. Demonstrate the Rotary ideal of "service above self" through family, school, and community involvement.
5. School and community service, citizenship, and leadership will be considered in awarding this Scholarship.
6. If awarded a scholarship, you have **ONE YEAR** from the award date to claim this scholarship.

Application Requirements

Applications missing any of the items listed here must be noted with explanation attached on separate sheet.

- Complete both pages of the application.
- Attach a one-page (single spaced) typed essay about **one** of the following:
 1. Hurdle(s) or challenge(s) you have had to overcome and how you responded to those challenges.
 2. Hurdle(s) or challenge(s) you anticipate having to face in the future and how you plan to address them.
- Attach a copy of your High School transcript. (To be verified later this year)
- Include *two* letters of recommendation. **One** from a school employee: teacher, counselor, or administrator, and **One** from a community member or family member. The candidate reference form can be used in lieu of a letter format.
